Objective: To provide a one-time award offering educational assistance for graduating high school seniors.

Consideration will be given to the following during participant selection:

- Commitment to pursuing either a two-year associate degree or a four-year academic degree at an accredited college or university.
- Academic record with Grade Point Average (no lower than 2.5 GPA)
- Financial need (low income)
- Teacher or Counselor's recommendations

Guidelines:

1. Complete Application (type or print)
2. Transcript (unofficial)
3. Letter(s) of Recommendation/Appraisal from teacher(s) or counselor of choice
4. Written Essay, 1 page, Write an essay about your background and origins, any cultural or historical details that are important to your identity. Finally, explain your goals for the future and your aspirations."
5. Picture attached to application

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3. Letter(s) of Recommendation/Appraisal from teacher(s) or counselor of choice
4. Written Essay, 1 page, "My Academic Goal after High School and Why." Please include some family background.
5. Picture attached to application
